June Primary Election 2012

Remember the League's resource for election information is: SmartVoter.org. This website can provide you with a sample ballot of the propositions and candidates on your personal ballot by inputting your address with zip code.

The deadline for registering to Vote in the June election is May 21, 2012.

There will be two State Propositions, 28 and 29, on this June 5 ballot. Proposition 28 has to do with term limits being changed from 14 years down to 12 and it is a Constitutional Amendment.

Proposition 29 is the increase of one dollar, \$1.00, on cigarettes. This money is slated for education on tobacco awareness.

There are also two County Measures on the ballot, Measure H and Measure L.

Measure H which is on extending the Hotel tax on rooms and services. Measure L is an extension of the Landfill Operator's tax.

Again check on SmartVoter.org to get information on your local candidates for Judges, State Senate, State Assembly, House of Representatives and any other jurisdictions.
